*5/24/07*

Northbridge VS Bellingham: Northbridge 17 Bellingham 4

*5/22/07*

Northbridge VS SPM: Different game, same story....Northbridge battled SPM to a 4-4 tie going into the 4th quarter and let it slip away. SPM scored 3 times against freshman goalie Stephen Karagosian who played well and stepped up in his first ever Varsity game. Senior Captain Bryan Burdick was not able to play in goal today and this had a definite impact on the outcome. Sophomore Joe Russo played 3 quarters and had 8 saves. Karagosian had 4 in the 4th quarter. Scott Dube scored 2 goals and Mike Padro had 2 goals and 1 assist. The defense (Tyler Martin, Drew Russell and Matt Cipelowski) continued their stellar play, letting SPM score only once in the first half.
